Is Steuben County Going to be Held in Contempt at Sibley's November 18, 2019 Second Amendment/Red Flag FOIL Lawsuit Hearing?

CORNING, New York – Last month, The Honorable Judge Wiggins issued an [Order](#) which held in pertinent part: “Should [Steuben] County again refuse to address the matter on the merits, it does so at the risk of default and/or contempt.” The Order set a new hearing for **Monday, November 18, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.** at the County Courthouse, Bath, New York.

Based upon the [failure](#) of the “[Answer](#)” filed by Steuben County to “address the matter on the merits,” Sibley has filed his “[Reply](#)” asking that Judge Wiggins impose sanctions. Said Sibley: “Where there's smoke there's fire, and Steuben County is blowing a lot of smoke at me and the Judge to prevent me from uncovering how New York's Red Flag law has and is being implemented. As Justice Louis D. Brandeis famously wrote: ‘*Sunshine is the greatest disinfectant*’ and I for one think New York's administration of Second Amendment rights needs to be thoroughly disinfected.”
